VICTORIA ROAD

Victoria Road commences with the police Station and continues to Middlecave Road. The whole of the space intervening between the former and the latter, where there is now a terrace of houses, was occupied by Messrs. Read and Sons' Iron Foundry, who at that time found work for a large number of hands. At the opposite side of the road, where Jesmond Terrace now stands, was an open field, and at the end of the road leading to The Mount, where Mr. Piercy now has his joiner's shop, Mr. Lucas had a Clay Pipe Manufactory nearby, where he made both long and short clay pipes and used to do a very fair business.
